Harper, which was bound to him by Indenture drawn by Downton Dennis Servt who persuaded me to bind the child which I unadvisedly did — And now finding him hardly I call by humbly pray that your worshipps will give her an Order to have the child that she may take care to putt him to a better place and your Petitioner as iidly bound shall for your worshipps ever pray —

The Petition aforesaid being read and heard, and all and singular the premises by well on the part of the afo Petitioner as on the part of the afo John Harper, and their severall Allegations on both sides by the court being fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon had —

Wherefore it is considered by the court that John Mathew son of the afo Jane Mathew's from his service afo be acquitt, and that the Indenture afo be adjudged not good b<sup>r</sup>. Whereupon it is ordered by the court that the afo Jane Mathew give good security to save and Indemnify Somerset County from all burthen trouble charge and Innuimbrance that might accrue by mean<sup>s</sup> of the afo John Mathew son of the afo Jane Mathew's manumission

Thereupon afterfull attencion present herein before undertaken for the said John Mathew and they both acknowledged themselves to owe and stand fully indebted unto his Lordship his hon<sup>r</sup> and sincefor in the sum offifti pound Sterling good and lawfull money of England to be levied upon their goods and chattell land, and tenement Doyally and Separately for the use of Somerset County if default be made in the condition hereunder written —

The Condition of the above recogniance is Such that if the above named Jane Mathew do and shall from time to time and at all times forever hereafter save and Indemnify — Somerset County from all burthen trouble, costs, charges, and Innuimbrance that might accrue by
