Ag^t Alexander Woodroffe | Command was given to the Sheriff of somerset County that he shoule
take John Hendry late of somerset County Merchant if he shoule be found
in his bailywick and him shoule rate keep so that he might have his body

before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of somerset to be held at Bridgwater before the
third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto Alexander Woodroffe of Agles of trespass
upon this case &c and that thereof he shoule not fail &c

And the afo^d Alexander Woodroffe by Levin Hale his attorney complaint against the
afo^d John Hendry in the plea afo^d as followeth &c

Somerset p. John Hendry late of somerset County Merchant was attested to answer
unto Alexander Woodroffe of Agles of trespass upon this case &c

And whereupon the same Alexander by Levin Hale his attorney complaint that whereas
the afo^d John the tenth day of September and anno. One thousand seven hundred and twenty seven
at somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted to the same Alexander with
in the sum of twenty two pounds Nine Shillings and Nine pence halfe Penny curr^t money of
pennsylvania of the value of twenty two pounds Nine Shillings & Nine pence halfe penny curr^t
money of Maryland for & were goods wares and merchandizes to him at his Expencable instance before
that time by the same Alexander sold and Delivered as by act^t here within Court produced may
appear and so thereof being indebted the said John in Consideration whereof afterwards to wit the
same day and year afo^d at the County afo^d and within the afo^d Jurisdiction upon himself agreed
and to the same Allex^d then and there faithfully promised that he when afterward he should be
thereto requested he the afo^d sum of twenty two pounds Nine Shillings and nine pence halfe
penny curr^t money of pennsylvania the same Allex^d would well and faithfully content and pay
nevertheless the said John his promise and assumption afo^d in form afo^d made not regarding
but plotting and fraudulently Intending him the same Allex^d in that part craftily and Subtilly
to defraud and Deceive the afo^d John w^t afo^d sum of twenty two pounds Nine Shill^t & Nine pence
halfe penny curr^t money of pennsylvania or any part thereof the same Allex^d hath not paid or him for
it in any wise contented altho the same to do the afo^d John afterwards ther^t the same day & year
afo^d at the County afo^d and within the afo^d Court by the same Allex^d was requested but he the
same hitherto to do hath altogether Refused and still doth Refuse whereby the same Allex^d
says he is worse and hath damage to the value of forty pounds curr^t money of Maryland
and therefor he Bringe his Suit &c.
