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Sl: Fran: Allen memorandum to the Court by Levin Gale his attorney sued out his Lordships writ of Summons
as against the deft the tenor whereof followeth in these words vizt -

Thomas Goddard. Somervell & Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland.

land and aersoned Baron of Baltimore Esq: To the Coroner of Somerset County Greeting Whereas -
that is Ellen Shew lately in our County Court of Somerset to wit the twenty first day of June Anno
one thousand seven hundred and twenty six before said Hopkins Gent and his associates then Justices of
our said County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek by Consideration of same Court recovered
against Thomas Goddard late of Somerset County Taylor as well a certain debt of eight thousand
pounds of tobacco as six hundred and eighteen pounds of tobacco which to the same Francis in our said Court
were adjudged for his costs and Damages which he had by occasion of the detaining of the same
Debt whereof he is bound as by the record and proof thereof in our same Court before our Justice
at Dividing Creek remitting manifestly appeareth notwithstanding Execution of the Judgment aforesaid
as yet remaneth to be done as by the Insinuation of the aforesaid Francis Allen we have learned and
because we are willing that these things which in our same Court are rightfullly cited ought
to be duly reported we command you that by honest and Lawfull men of your Body with you make
known to the aforesaid Thomas Goddard that he be before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset
to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March next to shew cause if any thing for him
self he hath or to say knoweth whereof the aforesaid Francis Allen execution against him of aforesaid
and Damages aforesaid to have ought not according to the recovery aforesaid it to him it seemeth Expedient and
law you know and there the names of them by whom to him you make known and this Writ.

At the which said Third Tuesday of March to wit the Nineteenth day of the same month and day
One thousand Seven hundred and twenty seven being the day of the return of the said Writ Cometh
the aforesaid Francis Allen by his attorney aforesaid and the Coroner of Somerset County to wit Henry Ballard
Gent: at the same day returned that he by virtue of the writ aforesaid to him directed he had made known
to the aforesaid Thomas Goddard that he be before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset
at the time and place aforesaid by Richard Stevens and Peter Persons honest and Lawfull men of his
County to shew &c And the aforesaid Thomas Goddard altho' so before warned, and at the same
day being solemnly called remeth not but makes default &c

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the Nineteenth day of March and day One thousand
Seven hundred and twenty Seven that the aforesaid Francis Allen have his Execution against the aforesaid
Thomas Goddard of Eight thousand pounds of tobacco his debt aforesaid six hundred and eighteen pounds
of tobacco his damages in the Judgment specified as also three hundred and thirty three - pounds of
tobacco for his damages sustained by occasion of delay of Execution of the Judgment aforesaid according to the
form of the Statute in such cases lately made and provided &c
