twenty second day of June last Doin: one thousand seven hundred & twenty before Charles Ballard Gentleman and his associates the Justices of our said Court at dividing Creek by Consideration of the same Court Recovered against Thomas Baker of Coventry Parish in the County of Loudsett planter ad: Dicto: Thomas Baker of Loudsett County in Maryland Lawer as well a certain Debt of Eighteen hundred Eight & a halfe Cotts of Cypress Timber Each quarter five foot four Inches Long, as three hundred and Eight pounds of Tob: Cotts said out & expended Whereof he is Convict as by the record and Proceeding thereof in our same Court, before our Justices at dividing Creek being manifestly apparent, Nevertheless Execution of the Judgment as yett remain: to be made as by the Insinuation of the ad: Thomas Billin & Catherine his Wife we have received, and Because we will that those things which in our same Court are rightfully done ought to be duly Executed, we Command you that by good & Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you Make known unto the ad: Tho: Baker that he be, before our Justices of our City Court of Loudsett to be held at dividing Creek the third tuesday of March next, to shew Cause if anything for himselfe he hath, or to say Knoweth, Wherefore the ad: Tho: Billin & Catherine his wife their Execution against him of the Judgment ad: to have Ought not according to the form of the Recovery ad: if to him it seemeth Expedient & have you there the names of them by whom to him you Make known & this Writt with us of said Hopkins Gent Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty fifth day of November in the twelfth year of our Dominion.

Att: which said third tuesday of March to witt the nineteenth day of the same month and Doin: One thousand seven hundred and twenty seven being the day of the Return of the said Writt Cometh the ad: Thomas Billin and Catherine his wife by their attorney ad: and the Sher: of somersett County to witt Hran: Allen Gent. at the same day Returned that he by virtue of the writt ad: to him directed, he had made known unto the ad: Thomas Baker, by Jm: Doe and Richard Roe good and Lawfull men of his bailiwick that he be, before his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County ad: at the day and place ad: to shew in form ad: &c.

And whereas upon the ad: Thomas Baker so before warned, and at the same day being solemnly called Cometh not but maketh default &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the nineteenth day of March and Doin: One thousand seven hundred and twenty seven that the ad: Thomas Billin and Catherine his wife &c. as ad: have their Execution against the ad: Thomas Baker of Eighteen hundred and Eight and a halfe Cotts of Cypress Timber Each quarter five foot four Inches Long. and three hundred and Eight pounds of Tobacco Debt and Cotts ad: according to the force form and effect of the Recovery ad: as also three hundred and eleven

311 pounds of Tobacco for damages which they had by reason of Delay of Execution of the Judgment ad: according to the form of the Statute hereof lately made and provided &c.
