

March Court - - - 1727 - - - - 74

Before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Diving Creek the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto John Barber of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. And that thereof he should not fail &c.

All which said third Tuesday of March to wit the Nineteenth day of the same month and Dow. one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven being the day of the return of the said writ from: the said John Barber in his own proper person and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise Cometh and Maketh the return thereof to the Court here Indorsed in these words following viz - Legi Corpus ff. Franc. Allen Sher.

And the said Samuel Turner by Levin Gale his attorney Cometh and doth shew the force and Injury whereof and the said J. Barber then and there his writ and against the said Samuel Turner did not prosecute with effect but voluntarily suffered his suit to be discontinued &c.

Therefore afterwards to wit the Nineteenth day of March and Dow. One thousand seven hundred and twenty seven by the direction of the Justices here were adjudged the same Samuel Turner the sum of One hundred and forty three pounds of toll for his Costs and Charges by him about his defence in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute in such case there of lately made and Provided and the said J. Barber in Mercy, and that the said Samuel Turner have thereof his Execution &c.

Therefore afterwards to wit the Nineteenth day of March and Dow. one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven by the direction of the Justices here were adjudged the same James Breman the sum of pounds of toll for his Costs & Charges by him about his defence in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute in such case there of (Lately)
