

March Court - - - 1727 - - - 74

Before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Widing Creek the  
Third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto John Barker of a plea of trespass upon  
Case &c. And that thereof he should not fail.

All which said third Tuesday of March to wit the Nineteenth day of the same month and year  
one thousand Seven hundred and twenty seven being the Day of the return of the said Writ com-  
mended to the aforesaid John Barker to his own proper person and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the  
foregoing writ was directed Likewise and Maketh return thereof to the Court hereof  
to the Court here endorsed in these words following viz - Legi Corpus pro me. Allen Sherf.

And the aforesaid Samuel Turner by Lewis Gale his attorney Cometh and doth set forth the force  
and Injury whereof and the aforesaid J. D. Barker then and there his writ aforesaid against the aforesaid said  
Turner did not prosecute with effect but voluntarily suffered his suit to be discontinued.

Therefore afterwards to wit the Nineteenth day of March and year One thousand Seven  
hundred and twenty seven by the discretion of the Justices here were adjudged the sum  
<sup>143</sup> of One hundred and fifty three pounds of tobacco  
Samuel Turner the sum of One hundred and fifty three pounds of tobacco  
for his Costs and Charges by him about his defense in that part sustained according to the  
form of the Statute in such case hereof lately made and provided and the aforesaid Justices  
order in Mercy, and that the aforesaid Samuel Turner have hereof his Execution.

D. Eliz. Rigen Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that  
he should take James Breman Gale of Somerset County Merchant  
if he should be found in his Ballywick he should safe keep  
so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lord-  
ships County Court of Somerset to be held at Widing Creek the Third Tuesday  
of March then next to answer unto John Barker Eliz. Rigen of a plea of trespass  
upon the case her. And that thereof he should not fail.

All which said third Tuesday of March to wit the Nineteenth day of the  
same Month and Year one thousand Seven hundred and twenty seven being the Day  
of the return of the said Writ come the aforesaid Eliz. Rigen by George Darrell  
her attly the Sheriff of Somerset to whom the foregoing Writ was directed  
Likewise Cometh Likewise Maketh return thereof to the Court here endorsed in these  
words following viz - Legi Corpus pro me. Francis Allen Sherf

And the aforesaid James Breman by Lewis Gale his attly Cometh and defendeth the  
force and Injury whereof And the aforesaid Eliz. Rigen then there her writ aforesaid  
against the aforesaid James Breman did not prosecute with effect but voluntarily  
suffered her suit to be discontinued.

Therefore afterwards to wit the Nineteenth day of March and year  
one thousand Seven hundred and twenty seven by the discretion of the Justices here  
were adjudged the same James Breman the sum of  
pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his defense in that  
part sustained according to the form of the Statute in such case there of
