Testament of Samuel Davis late of Somerset County, dec'd was attached to answer unto Alexander Wordie of a plea of the said upon the fore p^r

And whereupon the same Alex^d. Wordie by Lewis Gale his attorney sheweth that where:
 : as the said Samuel in his life time the tenth day of May one thousand seven hundred & twenty
 five at Somerset County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted to the said Alex^d.
 in the sum of four pounds nine Shillings current Money and so thereof being indebted said
 Samuel in his life time afterwards to wit the same day and year as at the County and within the
 of Jurisdiction in Consideration upon himself assumed and to the same Alex^d. Wordie there faithfully
 promised that he when afterwards he should be required to pay the said sum of four pounds
 nine Shillings current Money to the same Alexander would well and faithfully content & pay never
 : the said Samuel in his life time and the said Philip since the death of the said Sam^l.
 the promise and assumption of the said Samuel in his life time so as the said Alex^d. Wordie
 regarding and clothing and fraudulently detaining the same Alex^d. Wordie in this part to def:
 : and deceive neither the said Samuel in his life time nor the said Philip since
 the death of the said Samuel to be whose Execution of the last will and Testament of the
 same Samuel was in due form of Law committed the said sum of four pounds nine Shillings
 current Money hath paid or the said Alex^d. Wordie for it in any wise satisfied altho the said Sam^l.
 in his life time afterwards (to wit) the tenth day of June one thousand seven hundred and seven
 hundred and twenty six and the said Philip since the death of the said Samuel the
 tenth day of August one thousand seven hundred and twenty six at Somerset
 County and within the said Jurisdiction by the same Alex^d. Wordie were thereto required but they
 and every of them the same hitherto to pay or the same Alex^d. Wordie for it in any wise satisfied
 have altogether refused and the said Philip the same to do still doth refuse
 whereby the same Alex^d. Wordie says he is worse and hath Damage to the value of nine
 pounds current Money and thereto he brings this Suit &c.

Shal be and shal be & Indoe keep & ret

And the said Philip Ruffell Esq. as afo by George Darrick his attorney Comor and defend, the force and Injury whereof. And prays Leave to Injunct hereunto until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the said Alexander Wordie here also &c.

Att which said Next Court to wit the fifteenth day of August one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven came again as well the said Alex^d. Wordie as the said Philip Ruffell by their attorneys and the said Philip Ruffell by his said attorney thereupon prayed further Leave to Injunct hereunto until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the said Alex^d. Wordie here also &c.

Att which said Next Court to wit the twenty first day of November one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven came again as well the said Alex^d. Wordie as the said Philip Ruffell by their attorneys and the said Philip Ruffell by his said attorney thereupon
