All which said next Court to wit the twenty first day of November and downe one thousand seven hundred & twenty seven cause again as well the afo<sup>r</sup> Benj<sup>d</sup> Wailes as the afo<sup>r</sup> Richard Holland by their attys afo<sup>r</sup> and the afo<sup>r</sup> Richard Holland by his said atty whereupon prayed further to Imparle hereunto untill next Court to be heldt it the same day is given to the afo<sup>r</sup> Benj<sup>d</sup> Wailes here also

All which said next Court to wit the twenty ninth day of March anno domini one thousand seven hundred & twenty seven cause again as well the afo<sup>r</sup> Benj<sup>d</sup> Wailes as the afo<sup>r</sup> Richard Holland by their attys afo<sup>r</sup> and whereupon the said Benj<sup>d</sup> Wailes by his said attorney Brays had the afo<sup>r</sup> Richard Holland to his witt affirmeas afo<sup>r</sup> may answer w<sup>t</sup> but the said Richard attid. solemnly called quies not but makes default v.

Therefore it is Considered by the Court her the same day and year last mentioned that the afo<sup>r</sup> Benj<sup>d</sup> Wailes have his execution against the afo<sup>r</sup> Richard Holland admt<sup>r</sup> of the afo<sup>r</sup> Samuel Shewell fourteen hundred and fifty three pounds off to his damage afo<sup>r</sup> and also Two hundred and Twenty five — pounds off to him for his damage sustained by Occasion of delay of Execution off the Judg<sup>t</sup> afo<sup>r</sup> according to the form of the Statute in such case lately made and provided, to be levied off the good, and Chattels which were of the afo<sup>r</sup> said at the time of his death, and whiche to the hand<sup>r</sup> of the afo<sup>r</sup> Richard hereafter should happen to come to be administris<sup>r</sup> v.
