body concerned as also <sup>to</sup> we the Subscribers, who was the Petitioners for the said order to certify

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should  
Take John Allen late of Mattagony hundred in the County of Gloucest  
if he should be found in his Bayliswick and him should safe keep so  
that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset  
to be held at Widemay Creek the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto  
Benjamin Waites of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c and that thereof he should not fail &c -  
And the said Benjamin Waites by Lewis Gale his attorney proceeded against the said John  
Allen in the plea aforesaid as followeth vizt -

Somerset of John Allen late of Mattagony hundred in the County of Gloucest was attached  
to answer unto Benj: Waites of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c

And whereupon the same Benj: by Lewis Gale his attorney Complaineth that whereas the  
said John the tenth day of Aug: and one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven at Somerset  
County within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted to the said Benj: in a Sum of seven hundred  
and Ten pounds of tob: or by Act: herewithin Court produced may appear and so thereof being  
indebted the said John in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the same day and year aforesaid at  
the County aforesaid and within the said Jurisdiction upon himselfe affirmed and to the same Benj:  
then and there faithfully promised that he when afterward he should be thereunto requested  
he should pay a Sum of seven hundred and Ten pounds of tob: to the said Benj: with well and fait-  
hfully Content and pay therewith of &c In his Promise and affirmation aforesaid in form aforesaid  
not regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending him the said Benj: in that part fraudulently  
and subtilly to defraud and receive the said Sum of seven hundred & Ten pounds of tob: of the said
