

March Court --- 1727 --- 82 ---
S. I. Murray S. C. [Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take John Webb late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto S. Murray of a plea of trespass upon the said D^r. And that thereof he should not fail to do At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the nineteenth day of the same month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven being the day of the return of the said writ brought the aforesaid John Murray by his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing warrant directed likewise brought and marked. Return thereof to the Court here endorsed in these words following Ver - Regis regis f me frans. Alter fieri -

Whereupon the said John Webb in his own proper person appears and thereupon the said John Webb at the prayer of the Plaintiff attorney and is adjudged to give Suretie Bail to the action and, but for want thereof the said J^d Webb is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County here to remaine w^t the said Sheriff present herein Court took charge of the said J^d Webb accordingly &c. And afterwards in the same Court came here after Abraham Smith of the County and Planter and undertakes for the said John Webb that if in case the aforesaid John Murray shall recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the aforesaid John Webb or that the said John Webb shall be therein Convict that then he the said John Webb shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his Body to the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in such fashion thereof or that he the said Abraham Smith will do it for him thereupon the said J^d Webb is discharged from the custody of the Sheriff and aforesaid.

Whereupon the aforesaid John Webb in his own proper person cometh and defendeth before the Court the said John Murray recover against the aforesaid John Webb five pounds two Shillings and five pence Run. money and costs off Suit against him which the said John Webb doth not gain stay aforesaid.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the Nineteenth Day of March
Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and twenty seven that the aforesaid John Murray recover against the aforesaid John Webb five pounds two Shillings and five pence Run. money his damages aforesaid in form and costes aforesaid also Two hundred and forty five pounds off tobacco for his costs and charges by him about his Suit in that part Expended to the same J^d Murray by the Court here off his aforesaid costes adjudged by the aforesaid Court in M^r Murray aforesaid
