Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take John Webb late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing week the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto Ed Murray of plea of trespass upon the fact. And that thereof he should not fail to

At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the nineteenth day of the same month and Dow one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven being the day of the return of the said writ Cometh the said John Murray by his attorney and the Sher of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise Cometh and maketh Return thereof to the Court here Endowed in these words following Ver- Legi Legum me Franci Allen Sher-

Whereupon the said John Webb in his own proper person appears and thereupon the said John Webb at the prayer of the Plaintiff attorney and is adjudged to give Special Bail to the action and, but for want thereof the said John Webb is committed into the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County there to remain. The said Sher. present here in Court took charge of the said John Webb accordingly. And afterwards in the same Court came here a certain Abraham Smith of the County and Planter and undertakes for the said John Webb that if in case the said John Murray shall recover Judgment in the plea and against the said John Webb or that the said John Webb shall be therein convicted that then he the said John Webb shall pay the condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his body to the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that he the said Abraham Smith will do it for him thereupon the said John Webb is discharged from the custody of the Sher. and so.

Whereupon the said John Webb in his own proper person Cometh and defendeth the force of Injury when the said writ saith that he cannot gain say the oath his action and against him brought nor can he say but that the said oath ought to recover his damages by Oration of the premises and to five pounds two Shillings and five pence and costs of Suit against him which the said John Webb doth not gain say.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the nineteenth day of March and Dow. One thousand seven hundred and twenty seven that the said John Murray recover against the said John Webb five pounds two Shillings and five pence and money his damages and in form. and Confessed as also Two hundred and forty five pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges by him about his Suit in that part Extended to the same Ed Murray by the Court here of his spent adjudged by the said Ed in Money.
