for his damages by way of attachment according to act of assembly &c. Whereupon for that
it seems to the Court here that the said John Evans has complied with the law as aforesaid
alleged, Therefore it is considered by the Court here the nineteenth day of March
anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty seven that the afoe John Evans recover
against the afoe Mary Evans aforesaid of the afoe Benjamin Evans the sum of Twenty
pounds current money his debts and as also all costs and charges by the said afoe deff.

and credits of the said Benjamin Evans at the time of his death, according to act of assembly
