And the afo Joseph Miffler by Lewis Gale his attorney Proceeded against the afo Andrew Wailes in the plea afo as followeth viz -

Sir: Please to take Notice that there is an action brought against you in Somerset County Court by fact Joseph Miffler which is to recover three thousand pounds of tobacco which you received for his use, and if you do not appear at the next Court to be held for the County afo, and defend the said Suit; attachment will be granted against your Estate by - - - - Lewis Gale Ques.

Witt Cometh the said Joseph Miffler by his attorney afo and the Sheriff of Somerset County to
whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise cometh and maketh Return hereof to the
Court hereunder in these words vizt. - Non Est Juvocatus Short note left at the last place
of abode of Francis Allen &c.

Whereupon the afo Joseph Miffler by his attorney afo says, that forasmuch
as he hath consulted with the law in order to an attachment he may have judgment against the
said Andrew Wailes for his damages by way of attachment according to act of Assembly &c. -
