That your Petitioner having by his De<sup>d</sup> Mother Catherine West a parcel of Land left him by will lying on the north side of Bank Creek being part of a parcel of Land known by the Name of Catherine Content being the uppermost part beginning at the dumb Landing containing One hundred and fifty aers, and the Bounders being not certain I humbly begg your Worships would be pleased to appoint some Commissioners to ascertain the Bounders of the said One hundred and fifty aers of Land and your Petitioner as bound shall ever pray -

Bel<sup>l</sup>. . . } the petition of Thomas Collier of Somerset County most humbly sheweth -

That your Petitioner is possessed of a tract of Land lying on the South side of Wickhamas River in the County afo called and known by the name of Hasey's Baillywick the boundaries thereof are much decayed and like to be lost, and the witnesses to prove them ancient and Infirm. Your Petitioner therefore humbly pray your worship to Issue Commission to such person as your worships shall think proper to Examine Witnesses to perpetuate the boundaries of the said Land according to the form of the act of asembly in that case made and provided and your Petitioner as in duty bound will ever pray -
