Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the aforesaid William Kennett give Security to comply with the
Covenants aforesaid Thereupon the said William Kennett, with John Collins and James Mansfield Junr.
his Security all present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe and
Stand truly Indebted unto the said John Rauchlife in the sum of thirty pounds good and lawfull money
of England of his body goods or chattels, Lands and tenements Joynally and severally to be made and levied
for the use of the said John Rauchlife his heirs and assigns if default be made in the foind sum
hereunder written -

The condition of the above Recognition is such that if the above bound
William Kennett do and shall well and faithfully serve the said John Rauchlife during his servitude
and the trade of a tinsmith, and to read well in the Bible, and to write, and at the Expiration of his
servitude to give him a new suit of Cloathes and aquire, and likewise to find and provide for his
said Servant during his servitude meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing mete for such servant
to have and wear, then the above Recognition to be void and of None Effect otherwise to remaine in full
force and vertue so -

Bell. } of Daniel Hule humbly present - Whereas your Petitioner is possessed of
a tract of Land lying in the County and on the north side of Marunscie Dam called Long Ridge
the bounds whereof are precarious and uncertain, your Petitioner therefore humbly praye you
worlgs to appoint Commissioners pursuant to an Act of Assembly in that case provided to examine
Evidence relating to the bounds aforesaid and your Petitioner shall as in duty bound pray

The Petition aforesaid being Read and heard and mature deliberation thereupon had
Wherefore it is considered by the Justices here that examination I passe out of this Court unto
the aforesaid Daniel Hule, and that Robert King, Ephraim Wilson, John Trehearn and Baug Walton
all of Somerett County Gentlemen be Commissioners & execute the same Commission according to Law in
such form made and provided hereto -

Amy Luke { Upon the complaint of aforesaid Daniel Luke of Somerett County in the Colony of Bergenia
bound to } against aforesaid Abraham Smith of Somerett County, for the detaining an Orphan named
Daniel Luke. Amy Luke in his custody who has an Estate in Bergenia, the said Abraham Smith and
Amy Luke being both present here in Court, according to Summons issued against them, and also the said
Daniel Luke being present, and the Court having heard their several Allegations as well on the part of
the said Daniel Luke as on the part of the said Abraham Smith, and the premises considered, and
taciturn as it doth not appear to this Court that the aforesaid Abraham Smith hath any right to
keep the aforesaid Orphan - It is therefore ordered by the Court that the aforesaid Amy Luke the Orphan
