In consideration of which Servitude, the said Amy Luke to be well and faithfully  
performed the said Daniel Luke undertakes for to leave the said Amy Luke during her  
Servitude to Knitt Sew and Spin, and to give her a year's Schooling, and to Learn her housewifery  
and likewise to provide for his said Servant during her Servitude meat drink washing Lodging  
and Clothing mete for such a servant to have and wear £2.

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the said Daniel Luke give Security  
for to comply with the Covenants aforesaid.

Whereupon the said Daniel Luke with George Dethorne  
his Securitie both present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to  
owe and stand Justly indebted unto the said Amy Luke in the sum of twenty pounds ster  
ling and Lawfull money of England Of their bodies goods or Chattels Lands or tenements  
for the use of the said Amy Luke her heirs or assigns eternally and seperately to be made  
and levied for defauult be made in the condition hereunder written £20 —

The condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bound Daniel  
Luke do and shall well and truly during his servitude aforesaid give of the said Amy Luke  
give her a year's Schooling, and to leave her to Knitt Sew and Spin and other housewifery  
and likewise find and provide for her during her servitude aforesaid meat drink washing Lodging  
and Clothing mete for such a servant to have and wear £2 Then the above recognizance to be  
void and of none effect otherwise £20.

John Merry — John Merry son of John Merry is bound by the Court unto Walter  
Darby to Darby until he arrives to the age of twenty one years he being fifteen  
Walter Darby — Year of age the sixteenth day of March, <sup>next</sup> the said John Merry to serve of  
Said Walter Darby the full term of time aforesaid, In consideration of which service the  
said Walter Darby undertakes to leave the said John Merry the trade of a Carpenter and to  
Read well in the Bible and to write during his servitude, and at the expiration of his servitude  
to give him ane suit of Coates and a set of Carpenters Tools, and likewise to provide  
for his said Servant meat drink washing Lodging and Clothing mete for such a servant  
to have and wear during his servitude aforesaid. Whereupon It is Ordered by the Court that the
