Eleventh day of April one thousand seven hundred & twenty seven & accordingly did meet
one of S^d Eleventh day & having summoned Will: Hayes W^m: Elgett & J^o: Records for
witnesses & use ~~contending~~ Party appearing or to appear that we know or heard of we did
proceed & being brought by said Hayes and Elgett to a marked white Oake standing one of
North west Side of Hitches Mill Branch on the South side of the Plantation where
M^r: Tho: Humphris Sen^r: did live being near of Middle way from of Main Road leads to Doctor B^{ns}:
Gunn which S^d Oake they both declared to be the Bounder of Hayes Lott as appears by there
Depositions here unto annexed & being brought up the S^d Branch above of house of the said
Tho: Humphris about two hundred yards above the Wading place of S^d Mill Branch that
goes over to Francis Luceakes & one of west side of the Water Course of S^d Branch they
where showed us a marked Black Gum standing in said Branch which S^d Gum W^m: Elgett
and J^o: Records did declare was the first Bounder of Atract of Land now in the Possession
of S^d Humphris called Green Hill as will appear by there Depositions hereunto annexed
