Comission and affidavits  
Greeting Knowye that we have appointed you or any three or two of you to be our Comissioners to examine Evidences on behalfe of aforesaid J. Douglon, Adam Spence esq:  
Edward Howard, James Martin and Thomas Robin all of Somerset County Gent<sup>l</sup> in relation to the Boundaries of severall Lots of Land lying in Snow Hill Town in the County aforesaid we therefore require you or any three or two of you at some time and place as to you or any three or two of you shall seem convenient you meet on the aforesaid Lots of Land (you first having taken your Oath on the Holy Evangelist of almighty God according to Act of assembly in such case made and provided) and there come to some before you or any three or two of you all such Evidences as shall be to you or any three or two of you <sup>if you examine it upon their Corporate Oath to be by you, or any three or two of you administered on the Holy Evangelist of almighty God touching the truth or</sup> promoubrances of their Knowledge or any thing that may relate to the Cause aforesaid and that reducing the severall Depositions into writing you send the same together with this our Comission under your or any three or two of your hands to our County Court of Somerset with all convenient speed Witness Samuel Hopkins Gent. Judge Justice of our said Court this

Thomas Shingo aged 82 or thereabouts being sworn upon the Holy Evangelist of almighty God Deporeth and saith that Bald Gyron Stump then in his sight was the first boulder of snow hill Town as aforesaid William <sup>sd.</sup> informed him and that the Land. Justices when they were present to ascertain the Bounds of said Land Town marked a tree oak then in his view near the said Gyron Stump in view of the said boulder and that the part of Bald Gyron directed at a small distance was by himselfe Cutt Down Exactly in the Line of the said Town as near as he could be

Adam Spence aged 67 or thereabouts sworn saith that the place where he stood and found a stake to be set up in the Southwestermost boulder of the fifth Lot belonging to snow Hill Town & that he saw Edward when the Town was layed out by the Justices the third and last time & that there he saw a stake set up by their order for the said Lot
