And the said Joseph Maffester by Leon Gale his attorney Cometh and defendeth the force and Injury which
 and saith that he cannot gainsay the action aforesaid of the said James nor can he say that the said Joseph
 did a shame upon himself in manner and form as the said James above against
 him hath Complained and as to the damage of the said James by him by
 occasion of the premises in that part Sustained the same Joseph saith and
 Confesseth that the said James hath Sustained Damages by occasion of the premises
 premises further then his costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that
 that part aposed to twenty two pounds six Shillings and Nine pence
 Current Money of Maryland and not more and because the aforesaid
 James Deny not this but the same Allegation Confesseth to be true pray
 Judgment and those Damages above Confessed together with his Cost and
