 One cause againe as well the aforesaid John Huntington as the aforesaid Robert Adkins by their attorneys aforesaid, and
 whereupon the aforesaid Robert Adkins prayed further leave therof to Imparte here until the next Court and
 he had it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Huntington here also &c —

At which said next Court to wit the fifteenth day of June anno Dowd. One thousand Seven hundred & thirty
 One cause against the said Robert Adkins by his attorneys aforesaid and offers himself against the said John Huntington

 aforesaid but the said Thomas Bredie altho solemnly called Cometh not nor is he with aforesaid further prosecuted &c —
