whereof he should not fail &c

At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the Seventeenth day of the Same month one thousand
Seven hundred and thirty being the day of the return of the said writt against the said Thomas Nathaniel
Williams in his proper person and the Just. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was
directed Likewise forth and make the Return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words follow-
ing vizt. Regi. Coram J. John Bunnell Just. —

And the said John Williams by Francis Allen his attorney comes and defends the force and
Injury whereof and prayed Leave thereof to imparele his unto until the next Court and he
had it and the Same day is given to the aforesaid Thomas How also &c —

At which said next Court to wit the fifteenth day of June. and. Dowd one thousand Seven hundred
and thirty one came again the said John Williams by his attorney aforesaid and offers himself
against the said Thomas Nathaniel Williams in the plea afo. but the said Thomas Nathaniel
Williams altho' solemnly called came not but made default nor is his writt aforesaid further presented
Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Thomas Nathaniel Williams and his pledges of presenting
be in mercy and that the afo. John Williams goe the afo. without day also it is considered that the aforesaid
John Williams recover against the afo. Thomas Nathaniel Williams his damages by reason of the premises
158 to one hundred and fifty Eight pounds of tobacco to the said John by direction of
the Justices here at his Request for his Costs and Charges in that part sustained according to the form of the
Statute &c by the Justices so judged &c

Same &c
