petitioned the Court for a road to be laid out for them to Snow Hill town &c. wherefore it is ordered by
the Court that Mr Samuel Hopkins and Mr James Martin lay out a road for the use of the Inhabitants
and others to Snow Hill town the most convenient and of the least prejudice to any person &c.
