John Holland, John Pitt, Wm Smith, Robert Hale Wm Broughton Wm Carter and James Moore  
who being duly elected tried and sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their oaths do say  
that the aforesaid Thomas Duncan is not guilty of the felony in the Indictment aforesaid above specified in  
manner and form as by the said indictment aforesaid above against him supposed.

Whereupon all and singular the premises by the court have been read and fully understood  
wherefore it is considered by the court that the aforesaid Thomas Duncan be quiet and goe hence without  
dayes — wherefore it is ordered by the court that the aforesaid Thomas Duncan Give Recouerance in  
thirty pounds Sterling with two Pounds fifteen pounds each for his said Thomas Duncan's good behaviour and  
appearance at November Court next £30.

Whereupon the said Thomas Duncan with Patrick Kerrie and Joseph Jones his security, before and  
said in Court acknowledged themselves to stand justly indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary  
his heirs and Successors in manner and form following that is to say the aforesaid Thomas Duncan in thirty pounds  
Sterling and the aforesaid Patrick Kerrie and Jos: Jones in fifteen pounds Sterling lack of their Goods and Chattels,  
Lands or tenements separately to be made and levied for the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors  
of default be made in the condition hereunder written

The condition of the above Recouerance is such that if the above bounden Thomas Duncan do and  
shall make his personal appearance before the Justices of his said Lordship's County Court of Quarterel to be  
held at Dwidning Creek the third Tuesday of November next and answer unto his said Lordship concerning  
all such matters and things as shall be then and there objected against him on his said Lordship's behalf  
and stand and abide the judgment of the Court thereupon and do not depart the same Court without license  
thereof and in the mean time to be of the behaviour to all his Lordship's Good people then the  
above Recouerance to be void and of none effect otherwise so — Likewise had the aforesaid Thomas Duncan in aid  
to him a County for the severall Officers he did due by reason of the premises aforesaid Whereupon the aforesaid Jos: Jones & Pat  
Kerrie presented before and under his said Lordship to say the severall Officers present by reason of damages aforesaid

John Riggis J. John Riggis I. d. appears according to his Recouerance for his Good behaviour and appearance  
at this Court and is discharged his and his security's £30 and is ordered to Give New Recouerance  
for his Good behaviour and appearance at November Court next £30.

Whereupon the said John Riggis with George Riggis his security both present before this Court in their pro-  
per persons and acknowledged themselves to owe to his Lordship the right hand the Lord Proprietary  
that is to say the said John Riggis in five pounds Sterling and the aforesaid George Riggis in five pounds also  
of other severall Goods and Chattels Lands and tenement to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and  
Successors of default be made in the condition hereunder written

The condition of the above Recouerance is such that if the above bounden John Riggis do and shall  
make his personal appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Quarterel to be held  
at Dwidning Creek the third Tuesday of November next and answer unto his said Lordship concerning all
