Wherupon the said Samuel Riggin in his own proper person appears, and being instantly demanded how he would acquitt himselfe of the premises ^{as} above upon him ^{imposed}, ^{he} ^{did} ^{make} ^a ^{protestation} of his Innocency because he would not plead with his said Lordship the Lord proprietary and putt himselfe upon the favour of the Court ^{whereupon} all and singular the premises ^{of} the Court here being seen heard and fully understood ^{wherefore} it is Considered by the Court here that the said Samuel Riggin pay to his said Lordship the Lord proprietary ^{the} ^{sum} ^{of} ^{five} ^{pounds} ^{sterling} for his ^{part} ^{of} ^{the} ^{premises} ^{above} upon him ^{imposed} and that the same Summe be taken in Satisfaction his said Lordship of the ^{part} ^{of} ^{the} ^{premises} ^{above} - wherupon the said Samuel Riggin is ^{advised} by the Court here to give Recognizance for his Good behaviour and appearance at November Court Next &c.

Wherupon the said Sam. Riggin with Henry Fitzwaters his Security both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe to his Lordship the right honorable the Lord proprietary that is to say the said Samuel Riggin in five pounds Sterling and the aforesaid Henry Fitzwaters in five pounds ^{sterling} of their severall Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the Use of his said Lordships his heirs and Successors if Default be made in the Condition ^{here} under written -

The Condition of the above Recognizance is Such that if the above bounden Sam. Riggin do and shall make his personall appearance before the Justice of his Lordship County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third tuesday of November next and answer unto his said Lordship Concerning all such matters and things as shall be then and there objected against him on his said Lordships behalf and stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereon and do not Depart the same Court without License thereof and in the mean time that he be of the behaviour towards
