Whereupon the said Samuel Riggins in his own proper person appears, and being distinctly demanded how he would acquit himself of the premises set above upon him imposed, ^{and} doth make a protestation of his innocency because he will not plead with his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary and putt himself upon the favor of his Court &c.

whereupon all and Singular the premises above mentioned being heard and fully understood Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesd Samuel Riggins pay to his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his by Question of the premises above upon him imposed and the aforesd same sum be taken in Satisfaction his said Lordship of the sum aforesd - whereupon the said Samuel Riggins is remitted by the Court here to give Recognition for his good behaviour and appearance at November Court next &c.

Whereupon the said Sam: Riggins with Henry Fitzwaters his Security both present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe to his Lordship the right honble the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Samuel Riggins in five pounds Sterling and the aforesaid ^{sum} Fitzwaters in five pounds Sterl. of their several Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the Value of his said Lordships his heirs and Successors if Default be made in the Condition ^{here} under written -

The Condition of the above Recognition is such that if the abovesayd Sam: Riggins do and shall make his personal Appearance before the Justices of his Lordship County Court of Somers to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November next and Answered unto his said Lordship concerning all such Matters and things as shall be then and there objected against him on his said Lordships behalf and stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereon and do not Depart the same Court without License thereof and in the mean time that he be of the behaviour towards
