in Court undertakes for the said Sarah Mankrite to pay the fine aforesaid and the Several Officers their fees due by  
Oath of the premises aforesaid . . . . . Likewise the said Sarah Mankrite is ordered to Give Security for

her appearance at next Court to Give Evidence against Johnson Hill at Suit of his Lordship's . . . . .

Whereupon the said Joshua Stinger present before Court undertakes for the said Sarah Mankrite in the Sum  
of ten pounds Sterling Good and Lawfull money of England to be Levied of his Goods and Chattels Lands  
and Tenements if default be made in the Condition hereunder written . . . . .

if default be made in the Condition hereunder written . . . . .

The Condition of the above Recognizance is Such that if the above Bounden Johnson Hill do and  
shall make his personal appearance before the Justices of this Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at  
Dwidning Creek the third Tuesday of November next to answer unto his said Lordship concerning as aforesaid  
then the above Recognizance to be void . . . . .
