 of the premises afo so afo upon him Imposed he is Gilly thereof. where upon all and Singular the premises

 and him did beat wound and Evil entreat so that of his Life it was Dispaired and ther harmes to him
 then and there did doo to his Great Damage and against the peace of the right Hon^{ble} the Lord propri-
 etarie his Good rule and Government whereof the same Lewis for the said Lord proprietary prays -
 adviseement of the Court here in &c = Gale of Don. prody
