In and upon a certain John Stewart in the peace of God and the Lord proprieetary then and there being an assault did make and him did beat wound and evill entreat so that of his life it was dispaire and other harmes to him then and there did doe to his great damage and against the peace of the Right Honourable the Lord proprieetary his good rule and government whereof the same Lewis for the said Lord proprieetary prayes advisement of the Court in ^{cō} —

Whereupon command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he shal take the said John Stewart if he to answer him and afterwards in the same Court have the said John Stewart in his proper person and being dirstantly demanded how he would acquit himself of the premises as above upon him imposed; says that of the premises as so much upon him imposed he is guilty thereof whereupon and singular the premises by the Court here being seen heard and fully understood — wherefore it is considered by the Court that the afo John Stewart pay unto his said Lordship the Lord proprieetary fifty pounds of tobacco for his fine by reason of the premises aforesaid above upon him imposed and that the said John Stewart betakes to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid —
