

His Lordship } Somerset County J. Be it remembered that upon the Twentieth day of August One thousand
 & William Beavis } Seven hundred and thirty one came into Somerset County Court Lewis Gale who for the Lord
 Proprietary proventer and gave the Court to understand and be informed that William Beavis
 of Somerset County planter at the County afo and within the Jurisdiction of this Court with force and arms
 did make and him did beat wound and cruelly treat so that of his Life it was despered and other losses to him
 he and there did doo to his Great damage and against the peace of the right honorable the Lord Proprietary
 his Good rule and Government whereof the same Lewis Gale for the said Lord Proprietary prayd Adviseant
 of the Court here in the premises — Lewis Gale Dowd pro ply

Thereupon Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take the said William
 Beavis if he was worth and afterwards in the same Court came the said William Beavis in his proper
 person and being thereupon Instantly demanded how he would acquit himself of the premises afo above
 upon him imposed, says that of the premises afo he is Guilty thereof —

Wherefore it is Resolved that the said William Beavis pay unto his said Lordship the Lord pro-
 prietary fifty pounds of Tobacco for his fine by occasion of the premises afo above upon him imposed
 and that the said William Beavis be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine afo —

 & } Summarias against the defendt the tenor whereof followeth in these words, vizt
 John Newbold et uxore --- } Somerset County J. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces
 & } of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To the Sher. of Somers-
 set County Greeting whereas John Hendry lately in our County Court of Somerset was to wit the eighteenth
 day of November and Dowd one thousand Seven hundred and Twenty Nine
 before Wm Plummer Gentleman and his associates the Justices of our County
 Court of Somerset at Brandy Creek and by Consideration of the same Court
 was ordered against Nathell Alexander Sale of Somerset County Administrator
 of the goods and Chattles of Henry Alexander decd forty two pounds four
 Shillings and Five pence Current Money of Maryland for his Damages
 which he Sustained by occasion of a certain promise and assumption to
 the same John Hendry by the aforesaid Henry Alexander in his Life
 time made and not performed as also three hundred and Ninety Eight
 Pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in
 that ^{part} apposed to be Levied of the Goods and Chattles which were of the
 aforesaid,
