 Rendred, Execution of the Damages and Costs aforesaid as yett remaineth  
 to be made Wherof to us the same John Hendry hath Suppliated —  
 himselfe of appropor remedy in that part to be provided and we in that  
 part being willing to do that which is Just Command you that by honest  
 and Lawfull men of your bailiwick you make known unto the aforesaid  
 John Newbold and Rachel his wife that they <sup>be</sup> before our Justices of  
 our County Court of Somset to be held at Diving Creek the third tuesday  
 of November Next to shew Cause if any thing for themselves they  
 have or know to say Wherfore the aforesaid John Hendry his Execution  
 - on against them of the Damages and Costs aforesaid to have ought.  
 - not of the goods and Chattles which were of the aforesaid Henry <sup>alleged</sup>  
 - or at the time of his Death in the hands of the aforesaid John Newbold  
 - and Rachel remaining to be Administred if so much thereof in their  
 - hands they have, and if so much thereof in their hands they have —  
 - not then the Costs aforesaid to be Levied of the proper Goods and Chattle

 the writt aforesaid to him directed he had made known to the aforesaid John Newbold and Rachel his wife that
