This same Sarah Mautrill cometh into Court in her proper person and prayeth that her appearance may be heard: Sarah Mautrill to save her Scurity from a certain Recouerance of Baile entered into for her appearance at this Court to give Evidence for his Lordship against Johnson Hile: Whereupon the Said Sarah Mautrill appears and her Scurity from the same Recouerance discharged. —

Whereupon the Said Sarah Mautrill is ordered by the Court here to give New Recouerance for her appearance at March Court Next to give Evidence against the Said Johnson Hile at Court in Lordships. —

Whereupon Joshua Slings of Somerset County planter present Cometh into Court in his proper person undertaken for the Said Sarah Mautrill and acknowledged himself to owe and stand indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor in the sum of ten pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of his Goods and Chattells Land and tenements for the use of his Lordship his heirs and Successors if default be made in the condition hereunder written. —

The Condition of the above Recouerance is Such that if the aforesaid Sarah Mautrill do and shall personally appear before the Justies of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of March next, then and there to give such Evidence as she knowes against the Said Johnson Hile of and concerning his committing of fornication with her the Said Sarah, and do not depart the same Court without License whereof then the above Recouerance to be void and of none effect otherwise. —

His Lordships Thomas Duncan cometh into Court and prayeth that his appearance may be heard: Thomas Duncan to save himself and Scurity from a certain Recouerance of Baile entered into for his Good behaviour and appearance at this Court to answer unto his Lordship. Whereupon the Said Thomas Duncans appearance is Recorded and he and his Scurity accordingly discharged. —

Whereupon the Said Thomas Duncan is ordered by this Court to give New Recouerance with two Scurities for his Good behaviour and appearance at March Court Next. —

Whereupon the Said Thomas Duncan with Abraham Smith and Dennis Durkay all of Somerset County planters present Cometh into Court in their proper persons and did acknowledge themselves to owe to his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor in manner and form following unto the aforesaid Thomas Duncan in fifty pounds, and to the aforesaid Abraham Smith and Dennis Durkay in twenty five pounds, Lawfull Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of their severall Goods and Chattells Land and tenements to the use of His Lordships heirs and Successors to be made and levied if default be made in the condition hereunder written. —
