memorandum: the debts by Francis Allen their attorney sued out his Lordship's writ of Habeas Corpus against the debtors the known who are followeth in these words videlicet - Somerset sh. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore. To the Sheriff of Somerset County here lying within Thomas Bering and Catherine his wife Executrix of the last will and testament of William White

late of the County aforesaid deceased lately in our County Court of Somerset holden with the nineteenth day of March and Dowd one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven before Samuel Roghair Justice and his associates then our Justices of our said Court at Dividing Creek and by consideration of the same Court obtained their Execution of aforesaid Judgment against Thomas Baker of Country parish in Somerset County planter ad dit. Thomas Baker of Somerset County in Maryland Sawyer as well of aforesaid debt of Eighteen hundred and Eight and a half bushels of good timber each quarter five foot four inches long and three hundred and Eighty pounds of tobacco bys said out and by paid as also three hundred and eleven pounds of to be by the same Court adjudged unto the said Thomas Bering and Catherine his wife for their costs and damages sustained by Quasion of delay of execution of the Judgment aforesaid whereof he is Committed as by the Record and proof thereof in our said Court before our Justice at Dividing Creek being manifestly appeareth Nevertheless Execution of the Judgment aforesaid as yett remaineth to be made as by the Insinuation of the aforesaid Thomas Bering and Catherine his wife we have received and because we are willing that those things which in our said Court are right fully acted ought to be duly executed we Command you that by good and Law full men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the said Thomas Baker that he before our Justice of our County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August next to show Cause if any thing he hath or knoweth to say wherefore the aforesaid Thomas Bering and Catherine his wife their Execution of the Judgment aforesaid against him to have ought not, according to the form of the Recovery aforesaid if to him it seemeth Expedient and have you there the Names of them by whom to him you make known and this with Writ of Samuel Roghair Justice Chief Justice of our said Court the nineteenth day of June in the fifteenth Year of our Dominion &c

At which said third Tuesday of August to wit the nineteenth day of the same month and Dowd one thousand seven hundred and twenty nine being the day of Return of the said Writ before his Lordship's Justices of the Peace at Dividing Creek Cometh the aforesaid Thomas Bering and Catherine his wife by their attorney aforesaid and the said John Burnall Gentlemen at the same day Returned that he by virtue of the writ aforesaid to him directed he had made known to the aforesaid Thomas Baker by James Baker and Joseph Morris good and Law full men of his Bailiwick that he before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek at the day aforesaid to show in form of &c as to him it was Committed which the said Thomas Baker according to the aforesaid to him withal performed by George Darke his attorney as Libertine Cometh and pray's leave to discharge himself until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Justice. &c also -

At which said next Court to wit the Eighteenth day of November and Dowd one thousand seven hundred and twenty nine came againe as well the aforesaid Thomas Bering and Catherine his wife by their attorney aforesaid as the aforesaid Thomas Baker by his attorney aforesaid and the said Thomas by his said attorney pray's further leave through discharge himself until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Justice &c also -
