Recognizance with two Sureties for his good behaviour and appearance at March Court Next to answer  
the premises aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said William Horsey with William Revell and Donwork Dennis Jm. &c. his Family, all present here in Court in their proper persons did acknowledge themselves to his said Lordship the Right honorable the Lord Proprietary in manner and form following Viz: the aforesaid W<sup>m</sup> Horsey in fifty pounds Ster. and the aforesaid William Revell and Donwork Dennis Jm. in twenty five pound Ster. Each Good and Lawfull money of England of these severall Goods and Chattels Lands and tenements to the Use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and Levied if Default be made in the Condition hereunder written &c.

The Condition of the above Recognizance is Such that if the above bounden Wm Horsey shall personally appear before the Justices of his Lord's County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing week the third day of March Next to answer unto his said Lordship concerning what shall be then and there objected against him on his said Lordship's behalf, and stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon and do not depart the same Court without Leave, and in the meantime that he be of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship and all his good people &c. then the above Recognizance be void and of none Effect otherwise &c.

Likewise it is ordered by the Court that a certain Patrick Burke Give Recognizance in five pounds Sterling for his appearance at March Court Next to Give Evidence on behalf of his Lordship the Right honorable the Lord Proprietary against William Horsey &c.

Whereupon the said Patrick Burke being present here in Court in his proper person acknowledged himself to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his said Lordship the Right honorable the Lord Proprietary in the Sum of five pounds Sterling Good and Lawfull money; of his good and Chattels Lands and tenements for the Use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and Levied if default be made in the Condition hereunder written.

The Condition of the above Recognizance is Such that if the above bounden Patrick Burke shall personally appear before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing week the third day of March Next and then and there Give such Evidence as he knowes against William Horsey on behalf of his said Lordship and do not depart that Court without Leave &c. then the above Recognizance to be void and of none Effect otherwise &c.
