

His Lordship - Whereas there was an Information exhibited to this Court against William Horsey for an assault made upon Captain Patrick Burke by the said William Horsey present before this Court is ordered to give Recouerance with his Penitency for his good behaviour and appearance at March Court Next to answer the premises aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said William Horsey with William Rovell and Donnoch Dennis Esq^r his Penitency all present here in Court in their proper persons did acknowledge themselves to his said Lordship the Right howtelle the Lord Proprietary in manner and forme following Vizt. the aforesd to the said W^m Horsey in fifty pounds Sterling and the aforesd William Rovell and Donnoch Dennis Esq^r in twenty five pounds Sterling each Good and Lawfull money of England of these severall Goods and Chattells Lands and tenements to the use of this said Lordship his heires and Successors to be made and Levied if Default shall be made in the Condition hereunder written &c.

The Condition of the above Recouerance is Such that if the above bounden Wm Horsey shall personally appear before the Justices of this Lord's County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of March Next to answer unto his said Lordship concerning what shall be known and have abjected against him on his said Lordship's behalfe and stand and hold the Judgment of this Court therupon and doe not depart from this same Court without Leave and in the meane time that he be of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship and all his Good people &c then the above Recouerance be void and of none Effect otherwise &c

Likewise it is ordered by the Court that Captain Patrick Burke Give Recouerance in five pounds Sterling for his appearance at March Court Next to give Evidence on behalf of his Lordships the Right howtelle the Lord Proprietary against William Horsey &c

Whereupon the said Captain Burke being present before this Court in his proper person acknowledged himself to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his said Lordship the Right howtelle the Lord Proprietary in the sum of five pounds Sterling Good and Lawfull money of his goods and Chattells Lands and tenements for the use of his said Lordship his heires and Successors to be made and Levied if default be made in the Condition hereunder written.

The Condition of the above Recouerance is Such that if the above bounden Captain Burke shall personally appear before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of March Next and then and there Give such Evidence as he knowes against William Horsey on behalf of his said Lordship and doe not depart that Court without Leave then the above Recouerance to be void and of none Effect otherwise &c

His Lordship - We of this Grand Jury do present Daniel Maddox of Somerset parish for breaking and entering of his peace at the home of Mr Lewis Pugsby - - - - M^r Lewis fountain foreman

Whereupon command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Daniel Maddox before to answer &c and afterward in the same Court came the said Daniel Maddox in his proper person and being instantly demanded how he would acquit himself of
