by taking their Corporall Oaths well and truly to Execute the Within
Commission according to the tenor and Effect thereof as Witness my
hand the day above Written - *Ja. Hopkins*

The Execution of the Within Commission and the Severall
Affidavits thereunto annexed was Duly taken this fifth Day of
November ann^d. Dom^o. 1731 - By us the Subscribers. John Miller
John Holland

In Obedience to the above Commission Directed to John Miller John
Single John Tull and John Holland all of Somerset County to Examine
Evidences Relation to the boundes of two tracts of Land the one Called *Cods*
Lott and the other *Lowes Quarter* we have met on the Said Lands -
this fifth Day of November ann^d. Dom^o. 1731 - Being first Sworne -
before one Justice John Miller and John Holland proceedeth to the
Examination of Evidences as followeth -

M^r. Samuel Hopkins Sen^r. Aged Sixty three years being first Sworn
on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God Saith that about twenty years
ago by Vertue of a Commission Directed to him and one William
Robinson out of Chancery being both Justices of Somerset County
to Examine *Cod. William Whittington* and what other Evidences
he should Nominate Concerning the Mouth of the Inlett Creek -
and accordingly the Said Whittington Directed us to the bottom of a
neck of Land where *Cap^t. John Smith* now Liveth and Declared on
his Corporall oath that was the mouth of the Creek where he began to
Survey a tract of Land Called *Cods Lott* where he ordered a leader post
to be artificially stuck in the marsh which said post or near the same
place is now Standing to the best of his knowledge and further Saith
not -

M^r. Benjamin Angdelott aged Sixty One years being Sworn as aforesaid saith he was Summoned
an Evidence on the aforesaid account and One *Walter Reed* with *Cod. Whittington* and that the aforesaid *Leader*
Post now *Standeth* near the place where the aforesaid Whittington swore was the mouth of the Creek
where the Land Called *Cods Lott* and *Lowes Quarter* was both Bounded and that Some Considerable
time before he carried the Chain when the Said Whittington Resurveyed the said tract of Land Called
Lowes Quarter and that he began at the place aforesaid for the mouth of the Inlett Creek and further
Saith not.

M^r. William Smith aged 37 years being Sworn as aforesaid Saith that he was with
Cod. Whittington when he went to the said Bounding and that the place or near the place where the
said *Leader Post* now *Standeth* was the beginning of *Cods Lott* and that he ordered the said
deposition
