therefore require you or any three or two of you at some time and place as to  
you or any three or two of you shall seem convenient you meet on the aforesaid  
Land called Barbers Rest (you first having taken your oath upon the holy  
Evangelist of Almighty God according to act of assembly in such case  
made and provided) and there cause to come before you or any three or two  
of you all such Evidence as shall be to you or any three or two of you  
nominated by the said Complainant or Dft: if any and that you  
or any three or two of you examine them upon their Colpeall Oath to be  
by you or any three or two of Administered on the holy Evangelist of Almig  
God in the presence of the Complainant (or Dft: if any touching the  
truth or Remembrances of their knowledge or anything that may  
relate to the cause aforesaid and that reducing the severall depo  
sitions into Writing you send the same together with this our commiss  
ion under your or any three or two of your hands to us to our County  
Court of Somerset with all convenient Speed witness Sam: Hopkins  
Gent: Chief Justice of our said Court the Eighteenth Day of June  
in the Seventeenth Year of our Dominion & anno Domini one thou  
sand Seven hundred and thirty one —

Now heretofore to wit the Sixteenth day of November one thousand Seven  
hundred and thirty one came hereinto Court Thomas Humpfrys and  
James Mackmorie two of the Commissioners mentioned in the above Commission and made return of  
the same with several depositions as followeth vizt —

July 26: 1731 came Thomas Humpfrys and James Mackmorie and was sworn on the holy  
Evangelist of Almighty God to execute his within Commission according to an act of assembly in such case made  
provided before me — — — — — John Hardy. —

Somerset County Esq: Memorandum: That the day to wit the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of August anno 1731 we the  
Subscribers vizt Thomas Humpfrys and James Mackmorie by virtue of a Commission hancanto annexed did  
on the Land mentioned in the said Commission called Barber's Rest belonging to Robert Hardy in this County and in  
relation to the first boundary of said Land took the following depositions vizt —
