Requested by the afo<sup>r</sup>d Sum of Six pounds ten Shillings Sterling unto the Said Edmund Jennings would well & faithfully Content and pay Newcholp the Said John his promise and assumption aforesaid in form afo<sup>r</sup>d made not Regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending sum the Said Edmund in that part Craftily & Subtilly to defraud and deceiv<sup>e</sup> the Said John Justice the Said Sum of Six pounds ten Shillings nor any part of it unto the Said Edmund hath paid or him for it in any wise Contented altho' the Said John his same to do afterwards to with the same day and year aforesaid at the aforesaid County by the Said Edmund was Requested but the same written to, to do hath altogether Refused and there doth Refuse to the damage of the Said Edmund Thirteen pounds Sterling and whereof he brings this Suit here

Whereupon the Said John Justice present here in Court at his prayer of the Plaintiff by his attorney aforesaid is adjudged to Give Speciall Baile to the action afo<sup>r</sup>d. Thereupon certain George Douglas, of Somerset County Gentleman present here in Court undertaken for the Said John Justice that in case the Said Edmund Jennings shall Recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the Said John Justice or that the Said John Justice shall be theron convic<sup>t</sup> that then he the Said John Justice shall pay the Execution of the said Judgment or Render his body to the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that he the Said George Douglas will do it for him &c.

And the Said John Justice by George Douglas his attorney comes and defends the force and injury wherein he and say, that he cannot gainsay the action aforesaid of the afo<sup>r</sup>d Edmund, nor but that he aumed upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid Edmund above against him complained, and as to the damage of the Said Edmund by him by reason of the premises in that part sustained the same John says and confesseth that the aforesaid Edmund has sustained damages by reason of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part appered to Seven pounds, Thirteen Shillings and Nine pence Sterling and not more and because the aforesaid Edmund denys not this but the same allegation confesseth to be true pr<sup>o</sup>p<sup>ri</sup> Judgment and those damages above confesed together with his costs and charges afo<sup>r</sup>d to him adjudged &c.

Therefore by consent of the parties aforesaid it is Considered that the afo<sup>r</sup>d Edmund Jennings Recover against the aforesaid John Justice his damages afo<sup>r</sup>d to the afo<sup>r</sup>d Seven pounds Thirteen Shillings and Nine pence Sterling by the same John in form afo<sup>r</sup>d confesed & also 245 pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges afo<sup>r</sup>d to the same Edmund at his request by the Court her and consent of the parties afo<sup>r</sup>d adjudged, with Day of payment while next Court which certain damages in the whole do amount to Seven pounds, Thirteen Shillings and Nine pence Sterling and pounds of tobacco and the afo<sup>r</sup>d debt in money &c.
