Whereupon the said John Justice present here in Court at the prayer of the plaintiff by his attorney aforesaid is adjudged to Give Special Bail to the action aforesaid, Thoroughout certain George Douglas of Somerset County Gentleman present here in Court undertakes for the said John Justice that if in Case the said Edmund Jennings shall Recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the said John Justice or that the said John Justice shall be therein convicted that then he the said John Justice shall pay the Satisfaction of the said Thoroughout or Render his body to the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that he the said George Douglas will do it for him &c.

And the said John Justice by George Douglas his attorney comes and defends the force and injury whereof and says that he cannot Gain say the action aforesaid of the said Edmund, nor but that he assumed upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid Edmund above against him Complain'd, and as to the damage of the said Edmund by him by invasion of the premises in that part Sustained the said John says and Confesseth that the aforesaid Edmund has Sustained damages by Invasion of the premises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appoyed to Seven pounds fifteen Shillings and nine pence Sterling and not more and because the aforesaid Edmund demurs not thereto but the same allegation Confesseth to be true pray Judgment and those damages above Confessed together with his Costs and Charges aforesaid to him adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties aforesaid it is Considered that the said Edmund Jennings Recover against the aforesaid John Justice his damages up to the said Seven pounds fifteen Shillings and nine pence Sterling by the same John in form aforesaid Confessed as also pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges up to the said Edmund at his request by the Court her and Consent of the parties aforesaid, with Stay of Execution until next Court which certain damages in the whole do amount to Seven pounds fifteen Shillings and nine pence Sterling and pounds of tobacco and the said debt in money &c.
