 the above warrant, was issued the following attachment against the Goods Chattels Rights of the above said Richard
 Driskell - vizt. — Somerset & Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the province of Maryland
 and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Just. of Somerset County greeting we command you that you attach
 any the Goods and Chattels rights and Credits of Richard Driskell late of Somerset County plunder if they shall
 be found in your Bailiwick to the value of twelve hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco and when you have the
 same attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you
 have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Divi-
 -ing Creek the third tuesday of November Next then and there to be condemned
 according to act of Assembly to and for the use of a certain John Burnall unless
 the said Richard Duskey by himself or his Attorney shall appear and ans-
 -were unto the said John Burnall in a plea of trespass upon the Case &c.
 According to Law and that by Good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick.
 you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the
 same attachment that he She or they be and appear before our Justices of
 our County Court of Somerset to be held as aforesaid to shew Cause if any-
 he She or they have why the same Goods Chattels Rights or Credits so attach-
 ed in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution
 thereof had and made according to act of Assembly in such Case made
 and
