At which said third Tuesday of November to wit the Sixteenth day of the same month and year One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety one being the day of the return of the same Writ witness the said John Burnall by Francis Allen his attorney and the Recd<sup>r</sup> of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise forth and make the return hereof endorsed vizt By virtue of the within Writ to me directed to the Justice within mentioned I certify that I have attached as heretofore and.

Chattels of the within named Richard Dursey in the hands of Moses Dursey to the value of twelve hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco and likewise by Richard Banmore and John Doe good and lawfull men of my Baily with I have made known unto the said Moses Dursey that he be and appear at the time and place within contained before the Justice within mentioned to show his or by the within precept I am commanded his

Whereupon the said Moses Dursey garnisher of the aforesaid Richard Dursey altho' solemnly called comes not nor shew cause why he but makes default.

Whereupon the said John Burnall by his attorney aforesaid present here in Court prays that upon giving security according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided he aforesaid sum of twelve hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco so as he attached in the hands of the aforesaid Moses Dursey may be condemned as of the good and chattels Right and credits of the said Richard Dursey towards satisfying unto the said John Burnall the aforesaid twelve hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco in the writ aforesaid mentioned as also all costs ensuing upon the same writ &c

Whereupon Francis Allen of Somerset County hath present before him and undertaken for the said John Burnall that if in case the said Richard Dursey do at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said John Burnalls claim against him appear to be satisfied or any way to have been undue before the laying of this attachment that then the said John Burnall shall make restitution unto him the said Richard Dursey of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue or that he aforesaid Francis Allen will doe it for him his

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the aforesaid sum of twelve hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco so as he attached be condemned in the hands of the said Moses Dursey as of the Rights and credits of the said Richard Dursey towards satisfying unto the said John Burnall as were the sum of twelve hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco as also all costs ensuing upon the writ of attachment aforesaid and that the said John Burnall have his aforesaid judgment against the said Moses Dursey &c
