By Hannah Waldron Adm^r of Jos. Waldron memorand: the p^t by Levin Gale her attorney Sued out his Lordships writ of attachment against the deft. the tenor whereof followeth in these words vizt

John Haristoy Somerset Esq^r Charles absolute Lord and proprietor of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon
Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To the Sher^t of Somerset County Greeting we command you that
you attach any the Goods Chattels Rights or Credits of John Haristoy Late of Somerset County Gentleman otherwise
Called John Haristoy of Boston in the County of Suffolk merchant if they shall be found in your County with
to the value of Twenty two pounds and Six pence Current money of Maryland and Eighteen hundred pounds
of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that
you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to
be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November next then and
there to be condemned according to act of Assembly to and for the use of a
certain Hannah Waldron Adm^r of Joseph Waldron dec^d Unless the said
John Haristoy by himself or his Attorney shall appear and answer
unto the said Hannah Waldron in a plea that he render unto her
the sum of one hundred and forty four pounds one Shilling Current
money of the province of the Massachusetts Bay of the value of
Twenty two pounds and Six pence Current money of Maryland -
which from her he unjustly detaines \$² According to Law and that
by Good and Law full men of your County make known unto
the persons or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment
that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County
Court of Somerset to be held as aforesaid to shew cause if any he she or they
have why the same goods Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his
her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof
had and made according to act of Assembly in such case made and
provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall
execute this Writ that you make known unto our said Justices at
the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this Writ

Ninth Day of October in the Seventeenth year of our Dominion \$²
Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty one -
at which said third Tuesday of November to wit the sixteenth day of the
same month anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty
one being the day of the Return of the same Writ Cometh the said
Hannah Waldron by Levin Gale her Attorney and the Sher^t of
Somerset County to whom the foregoing Writ was directed Likewise
