And the said James Phillips by Francis Allen his attorney Cometh and defendeth the same and Injury whereto  
and the said Thomas Bannister altho' formerly called Cometh not nor further prosecute his writ aſt against the said James

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid Thomas Bannister and his pledges of prosecuting be in money  
and that the aforesaid name his pledges &c and that the aforesaid James Doe stand without day. It is also Considered that  
the aforesaid James Phillips Render against the aforesaid Thomas Bannister his damages by reason of the premises to  
one hundred & forty eight pounds of tobacco to the same James by direction of the Justices here
