the afo James Phillips Receiver against the afo Thomas Bannister his damages by Oath of the premises to
148. One hundred & forty eight . . . pounds of tobacco to the same James by direction of the Justices here
at his request for his costs and charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute thereof lately
made and provided by the Court here adjudged &c.
