To the worshipfull the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset

now in Court Sittig. The humble petition of Richard Barker most humbly sheweth

That whereas your petitioner is possessed with about of Land lying on posomoke River in the
County aforesaid called Wiskemey neck contained six hundred acres the boundary thereof being decayed and
the witnesses to prove them ancient and in firm whencefore your petitioner prays you to Grant a Commission
according to an act of Assembly in such case provided to examine Witnesses to prove their Boundary
of the said Land in perpetuall memory and your petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.

The petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood, Therefore it is considered by the
Court here that a Commission shal be to the aforesaid Richard Barker as by his petition aforesaid is praid
in that James Martin, Isaac Morris, Edmund Hough and John Dennis etc of Somerset County Gent: be Commis-
sioners and execute the same Commission according to Law &c.

Ordered by the Court that Daniel Maddox pay unto Lewis Rigby William Horner Alexander Penn
and Francis Crowder Sixty pounds of tobacco each for their attendance two dayes each as Evidence for the Lord pro-
prietor against the said Daniel Maddox they having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that John Riggins Dmd. pay unto George Riggins Deane Donohoe and Charles Rig-
gin two hundred and forty pounds of tobacco each for their attendance eight days as evidence each for the
said John Riggins against John Cutten they having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that John Riggins Dmd. pay unto John Riggins next One hundred and eighty pounds of
tobacco being due unto him for his attendance as evidence Six days on behalfe of the said John Riggins Dmd. agt.
John Cutten he having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that Patrick Daley pay unto John Denton Ninety pounds of tobacco being due unto him
for his attendance three dayes as evidence on behalfe of his Lordship the right wch the Lord proprietor against
the said Patrick Daley he having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that John Caldwell and Ebenezer Hand both of Somerset County Gentlemen
agree with some person or persons to build a good and sufficient bridge over the Creek in Nanticoke Marsh
that the road maye over that Leads to viannerferry, and they to make their Report to the next Court and
the Builders to be allowed for the same at the next Levee Court &c.

Ordered by the Court that Mephus, John Caldwell Ebenezer Hand Edward Rownd and James Rownd
Inspect and Order the clearing of a road from the head of Wiskemoye River over the head of Coronado
by Samuel Trevitt to the main Road at Buckingham &c and that the said Samuel Trevitt be Overseer of
the Road from Coronado to Wiskemoye, and that Andw. Smith be Overseer of the Road from Bucking-
ham to Coronado to the said Trevitt &c.
