To the worshipfull the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset  
now in Court sitting. The humble petition of Richard Barker most humbly sheweth

That whereas your petitioner is possessed with a tract of Land lying on the River in the County aforesaid called Wickenway neck contained six hundred acres the boundary thereof being decayed and the witnesses to prove them ancient and in firm wherefore your petitioner prays you to Grant a Commission according to an Act of a Assembly in such case provided to examine Witnesses to prove the boundaries of the said Land in perpetuall memory and your petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.

The petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood, Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that a Commission Issue to the aforesaid Richard Barker as by his petition aforesaid is prayed and that James Martin, Isaac Morris, Edmund Hough and John Dennis all of Somerset County Gent: be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to Law &c.

Ordered by the Court that Daniel Maddox pay unto Lewis Riggs by William Horner Alexander Chami and Francis Crowder Sixty pounds of tobacco each for their attendance two days each as evidence for the Lord proprietary against the said Daniel Maddox they having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that John Riggins Junr pay unto Teague Riggins Teague Donohoe and Charles Riggs two hundred and forty pounds of tobacco each for their attendance eight days as evidence each for the said John Riggins against John Coker they having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that John Riggins Junr pay unto John Riggins senr One hundred and eighty pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance as evidence six days on behalfe of the said John Riggins Junr: agt. John Coker he having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that Bahrick Daley pay unto John Denton Ninety pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance three days as evidence on behalfe of his Lordship the right honorable the Lord proprietary against the said Bahrick Daley he having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that John Caldwell and Ebenezer Handy both of Somerset County Gentlemen agree with some person or persons to build a good and sufficient bridge over the creek in Nanticoke Marshes that the road goes over that Leads to Wainnes Ferry, and they to make their Report to the next Court and the Builders to be allowed for the same at the next Levy Court &c.

Ordered by the Court that Messrs John Caldwell Ebenezer Handy Edward Rownd and James Rownd Inspect and Order the clearing of a road from the head of Wicaronow River over the head of Coromocke by Samuel Frewitt to the main Road at Buckingham &c and that the said Samuel Frewitt be Overseer of the Road from Coromocke to Wicaronow, and that Andw. Smith be Overseer of the Road from Buckingham to Coromocke to the said Frewitt &c.
