

Att wch said third tuesday of November keept to wth the sixteenth day of the same month one thousand seven hundred and thirty one the Sheriff of the County aforesd then being at the same day before his Lordships Justices at the County Court of Somerset at Bridgwater returned that by vertue of the precept aforesd to him thereof directed he had taken the body of the aforesd Mary Boniter whose body he had there ready & was on the said R^d alio solemnly called bring not in the body of the said Mary Boniter according to the return of the will aforesd whereupon at the prayer of the said R^d further day is given to him until the next Court to bring in the said Mary Boniter to answer her.

At which said next Court to wth the twenty first day of March one thousand seven hundred and thirty one came the said Mary Boniter in her proper person, and therupon the said Mary Boniter is immediately asked after what manner she would acquit herself of the premises in the presentment aforesd above upon her imposition: said, the same Mary says that she cannot deny but that she is guilty of the premises aforesd in the presentment aforesd specified above upon her imposition and makes oath that certain John Webb; the begetter of the R^d she then stood presented for her whereupon ~~she~~ all and singular the premises by the Court here seen stand and fully understood her.

It is considered by the Court here that the said Mary Boniter pay to his said Lordship for her fine by the Court here upon her imposition for and by question of the premises, whereof in sum aforesd she is bound Six hundred pounds of stob. (to the use of the County aforesd) and that the said Mary Boniter be liable to pay his said Lordship of the fine aforesd, whereupon the said Mary Boniter is ordered to give security for the fine aforesd and all the Officers fees due by question of the premises aforesd, whereupon certain Edward Boniter of Somerset County planter undertakes for the said Mary Boniter to pay the fine aforesd and the severall Officers their fees due by question of the premises aforesd.

Likewise it is ordered by the Court here that the said Mary Boniter give security for her appearance before the Justice of his Lordships County of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater from the third Tuesday of June next to evidence on behalf of his said Lordship against the said John Webb. &c.

Whereupon the aforesd Edward Boniter present herein bound undertakes for the said Mary Boniter to acknowledge himself to be indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds Sterling of his good and chattell Lands and tenements to be made to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and successors &c. In case the said Mary Boniter do not make her personal appearance before the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of June next and doth remonstrance and there give such evidence as the Plaintiff know against the aforesaid against the said John Webb of and concerning such things as the same stands charged with; and doth not depart the same Court without Licence thereoff &c.

This Lordship of Somerset County by Recd remembred that on the sixth day of October Anno Domini seventeen hundred and thirty one comes in his Lordships Court before the Worshipfull Samuel Hopkins Esq^r and other Associates Justices of the same Court Lewis Hale Esq^r prosecutor of his Lordship's - pleads -
