

At which said third tuesday of November next to witt the sixteenth day of the same month one thousand seven hundred and thirty one the Sheriffs of the County aforesaid then being at the same day before his Lordships Justices at the County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek Returned that by Vertue of the precept aforesaid to him thereof Directed he had taken the body of the aforesaid Mary Boniter whose body he had there ready &c. — whereupon the Said Sheriffs solemnly called bring not in the body of the said Mary Boniter according to the Return of the witt afo, whereupon at the prayer of the Said Sheriffs further day is given to him, until the next Court to bring in the Said Mary Boniter to answer &c. —

At which said next Court to witt the twenty first day of March one thousand seven hundred and thirty one came the Said Mary Boniter in her proper person, and thereupon the Said Mary Boniter is immediately asked after what manner she would acquitt herself of the premises in the presentment aforesaid above upon her Imposed: said, the Same Mary says that she cannot deny but that she is Gilty of the premises aforesaid in the presentment aforesaid Specified above upon her Imposed and makes Oath that a certain John Webb is the begetter of the Child she then stood presented for &c. whereupon ~~after~~ all and Singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood &c.

It is Considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Mary Boniter pay to his said Lordship for her fine by the Court here upon her Imposed for and by Occasion of the premises, whereof in form aforesaid she is Committed Six hundred pounds of tere. (to the use of the County aforesaid) and that the Said Mary Boniter be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid, whereupon the Said Mary Boniter is ordered to give Security for the fine afo and all the Officers fees due by Occasion of the premises aforesaid, whereupon a certain Edward Boniter of Somerset County planter undertakes for the said Mary Boniter to pay the fine aforesaid and the Severall Officers their fees due by Occasion of the premises afo —

Likewise it is ordered by the Court here that the said Mary Boniter give Security for her appearance before the Justices of this Lordships County of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third tuesday of June next to give evidence on behalf of his said Lordship against the said John Webb &c.

Whereupon the aforesaid Edward Boniter present before the Court undertakes for the Mary Boniter & acknowledges himself to be indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling of his goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements to be made to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and assigns &c. In Case the said Mary Boniter do not make her personal appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third tuesday of June next ~~and~~ and there by give such Evidence as she shall know against the children against the said John Webb of and concerning such things as she shall stand charged with; and doe not depart the same Court without Licence thereof &c.
