 the peace of God ^{and} of the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary then and there being
 an assault did make and him did beat wound and will Entreat and other-
 harms to the said Patrick then and did against the peace ^{and} against the good rule
 and Government of the Lord Proprietary wherefore the said Levin Gale pray
 the advise of the Court in the premises and due process of Law thereupon to-
 be awarded ^{as} and in manner here at this term hold for Somerset County at dividing Creek this
 twenty first day of March One thousand Seven hundred and thirty one, before his Justice ^{of his County Court} Lordship the aforesaid
 William Horsey according to a certain Recouerance by him and his pledges in that part first acknowledged
 in his proper person, and hath abearing of the information aforesaid, who says that he is not therof
 guilty and of this he puts himselfe upon the Country and Levin Gale Esq: his Lordships attorney ^{as}
 who for his said Lordship in that part followeth likewise ^{as}

whereupon I immediately cometh therefore this day before the aforesaid Justices last named herebefore ^{as}
 who neither do to Recouer ^{as} because as well ^{as} and the Juron of the same day by the Sheriffs
 of Somerset County ^{to his} being impannelled to be being called paire to witt Barker Selby, John Burnall Due.
 Peter Fraser, Joshua Drayton, John Roach, Isaac Alderson, John Birmingham Robert Mitchell, John
 Webb Richard Knight Thomas Collins and Angelo Alderson, who to say the truth in the premises being
 duly deputed byed and sworn upon their Oath do say that the aforesaid William Horsey is not guilty of
 the trespass and assault by the information aforesaid above upon him imposed ^{as} upon him the premises
 being by the Court here seen heard and fully understood ^{as}

Wherefore it is considered that the aforesaid ^{new} Horsey be quitted and have thereof without day ^{as}

whereupon it is ordered by the present that the aforesaid William Horsey give security for the
 payment of the severall Officers their fees due by reason of the premises aforesaid wherein also the
 Horsey of Somerset County hath undertaken for to pay to severall Officers paid due by reason of the premises aforesaid
