Nowheral this twenty first day of march one thousand Seven hundred
and Ninety One before his Lordship, Justices, of the County Court of Somerset Relied at Widning Beck
concerning the aforesaid Thomas Brugally and Catherine Brugally before the aforesaid Justices here in their pro-
per persons, according to a certain Recognizance by them and their family in that part first acknowledged,
and whereupon the said Thomas Brugally and Catherine Brugally are discharged from their Recognizance
aforesaid, and ordered to give security for the payment of the several Officers fees due by occasion of
the premises aforesaid. Whereupon a certain John Dennis did present herein Court undertaken for the said
Thomas Brugally and Catherine Brugally to pay the several Officers their fees due by occasion of the
premises aforesaid &c

Wm Smith, David Dredon, Margt Williams and Thomas Layfeld all severally appeared herein Court
to give evidence agt Tho Brugally and Catherine Brugally, and were accordingly set discharged from their
same Recognizances &c

His Lordship } Somerset P. Be it Recounted that upon the twenty first day of march and Dowd
D'Other Mulligan - One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety One came here into Somerset County Court -
Lenn Gale Esq: Clerk of the Indictments, of the said County, and for the said Lord pro-
prietary gave the Court to understand and be informed that D'Other Mulligan late of Somerset County
Esq: after the tenth day of November and Year aforesaid at the County aforesaid within the jurisdiction of
this Court did commit fornication and born of her body a bastard child against the peace of the Right
Honourable the Lord Proprietary his Good Rule and Government and also against the form of the act of assem-
bly in such case made and provided whereof the said Lenn Gale for the said Lord Proprietary prays advancement of
the Court in the premises &c

Afterwards in the same Court he to wit this twenty first day of March and Dowd One thousand Seven
hundred and Ninety One in his proper person cometh the said D'Other Mulligan and being immediately asked
how she would acquit herself of the premises above by the information upon her imposed. Say. that of the
premises above upon her imposed she is guilty thereof, and makes oath that a certain Geo: Layfeld is
the father of the child as she stands accused of and is willing to pay her fine for the fact aforesaid &c

whereupon all and singular the premises by reason here being seen heard and fully understood It is
considered by the Court here that the aforesaid D'Other Mulligan pay to his said Lordship for her fine by the Court
here upon her imposed for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid, whereof in sum and total is Committed to Henry
P. Ellings (to the use of the County) and that the said D'Other be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid
and Likewise the said D'Other is bound by the Court here that she shall give security for the payment of a sum and a
several Officers fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid whereupon a certain Wm Land officer of County Court present
here to Court in his proper person and makes, in the said D'Other to pay the fine and fees aforesaid
