His Lordship. It is ordered by the Court here that William Wye Esq. give Security for his appearance at before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of ^{to be held at Dwidning Creek} Somerset, the third Tuesday of June next to Wm Wye Esq. prosecute and give Evidence on behalf of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary against Wm Horsey on an Information for Adultery &c. the said William Wye Esq. with William Wye Esq. Late of Somerset County Clerk his Securitie both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe to his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary the sum of ten pounds Sterling each of their severall Goods, and Chattells Lands, and tenements to the use of his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors to be made and levied; if it happen the said William Wye Esq. do not make his personale appearance before the Justice of his said Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwidning Creek the third Tuesday of June next, and do not then and there prosecute and give such evidence as he shall know on an Information against the said William Horsey, and do not depart the same Court without Licence thereof &c.

The Same. Afterm Bridgett Colligon present here in Court is ordered to give Security for her appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwidning Creek the third Tuesday of June next to give evidence for his Lordship against William Horsey on an Information for Adultery &c.

Whereupon a certain William Wye esq; and Richard Knight both of Somerset County Gentlemen present here in Court in their proper persons undertook for the said Bridgett Colligon and acknowledged themselves to owe unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds Sterling each of their severall Goods and Chattells Lands, and tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made & levied; if it happen the said Bridgett Colligon do not make her personale appearance before the Justice of his said Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwidning Creek the third Tuesday of June next, and do not then and there give such Evidence as she shall know against the said William Horsey on an Information for Adultery, and do not depart the same Court without Licence thereof &c.

His Lordship. Upon the complaint of Capt. John Scott one of the Lord Proprietary's Indians of the Bah. Connerly. ^a peace for the County of Somerset, to this Court, that he was abused, and affronted in the contrary to an act of Assembly in such case made & provided by the Exemption of his Office by a certain Bahrick Connerly, the said Bahrick Connerly present here in Court in his proper persons, & immediately asked how he would acquitt himself of the premises above upon him imposed, the same Bahrick ^{Connerly} say that he cannot deny but what he is guilty of the premises above upon him imposed, and putteth himself upon the favour of the Court.

Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood - It is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Bahrick Connerly pay to his said Lordship for his fine by the Court.
